Thank you so much for your time, and we hope you can make it.

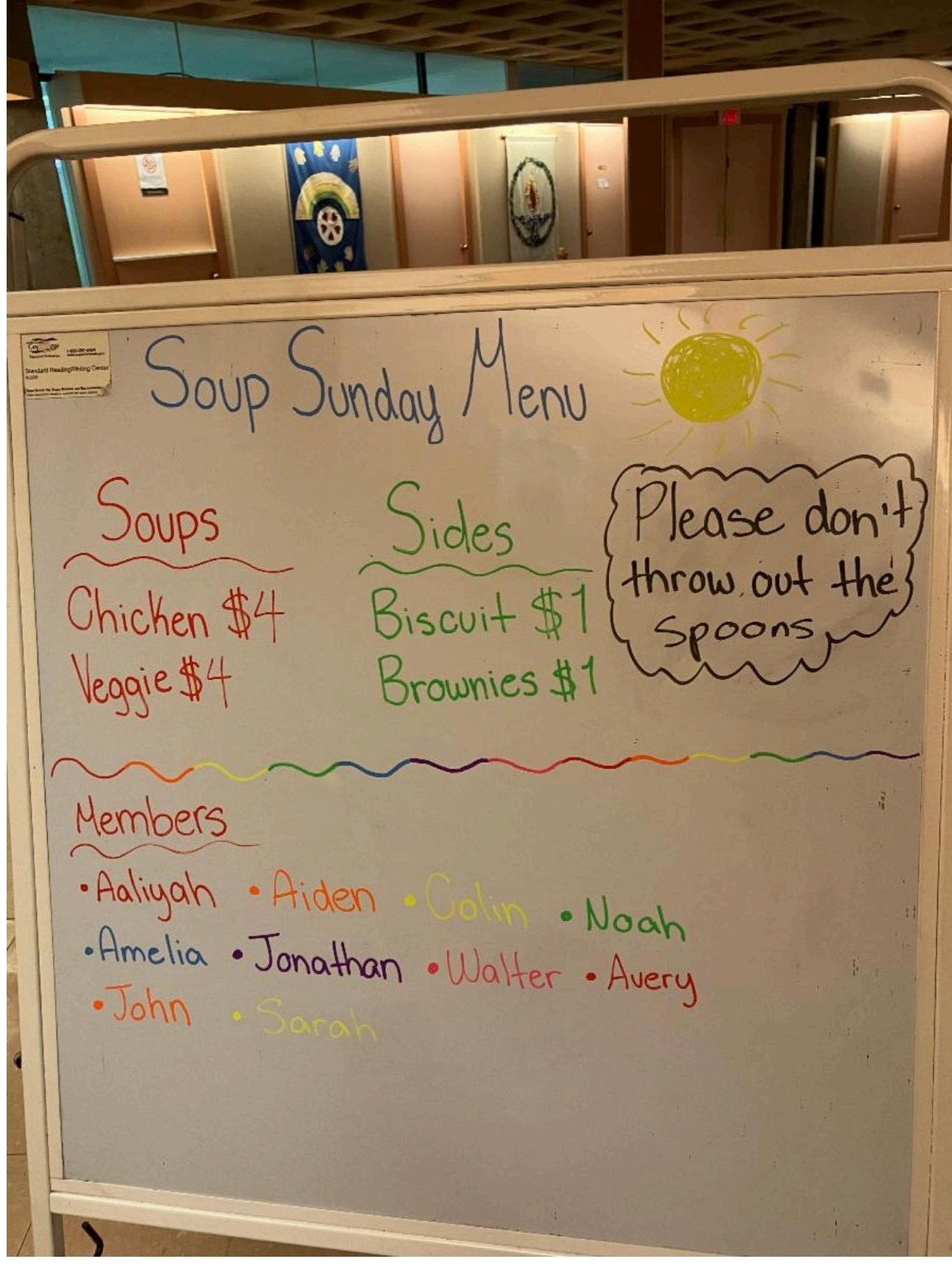
